GCSE

Results were impressive in English, with over 88% of students achieving at least a grade 4 pass and over 75% of students achieving a grade 4 in Maths. Outstanding results were also achieved in Art, where 89 % of students were awarded a grade 5 or above. Overall, an amazing 134 grade 8s and 9s were achieved, with 7 of our year 11 students achieving 7 or more GCSEs at the highest grades 8 and 9. In many subjects students outperformed the national picture.
